- Mixed session for Asian equities the Nikkei is at -1.19%, the Shanghai composite is at -0.05%, the Hang Seng is at -0.30%, and the ASX is at +0.49%.
- AUD is extending losses today DXY index is at 102.40, the EUR is at 1.0794, USD/JPY is at 128.44, while the AUD is at 0.6903.
- US treasury yields are sharply lower on disappointing economic data the 2 year yield is at 4.249% while the 10 year yield sits at 3.359%
- Gold is trading the \$1900-10 range in Asia after a choppy session overnight, the yellow metal is at \$1907 as I write.
- Silver was dumped overnight, the grey metal is currently trading at \$23.43.
- Gold ETFs sold 10koz overnight to a gross total of 93.90 million ounces.
