## MACRO

- US equities were lower in fairly light Columbus Day trading.
- The Dow lost 33.39 points to 22,740.28, the S&P 500 fell 3.05 points to 2,543.31, while the Nasdaq slipped 10.45 points to 6,579.731.
- There were wins for energy (+0.24%) and tech (+0.25%) while healthcare (-0.67%) and industrials (-0.39%) led the laggards.
- The VIX gauge added 7.36%.
- The US dollar index shed 0.18% to 93.633, the EUR traded up to 1.1754, while USD/JPY traded as low as 112.37.
- The US bond market was closed for the Columbus day holiday.
- European shares were mostly mixed, the EuroSTOXX 600 rose 0.19%, the German DAX advanced 0.16%, while the UK FTSE declined 0.20%.
- Oil prices were higher, Brent firmed 0.11% to \$55.68 while WTI gained 0.51% to \$49.54.
- Base metals were mostly higher, with nickel (+3.92%) the big winner.
- No US economic data released overnight.

## PRECIOUS

- Positive session for the precious as China returns from holidays.
- Gold opened at \$1275 in Asia and climbed quickly to \$1284 on the SGE open.
- The SGE premium rose to an elevated \$12-13 which prompted good buying out of China.
- The market came off a few dollars heading into the London open.
- The yellow metal closed above the \$1280 level after a range-bound NY session.
- Silver also found good support during Asian hours, the grey metal closing ahead at \$16.94.
- Platinum closed flat and palladium finished 1% higher in choppy trade.
- The Philadelphia gold and silver index added 0.88%.
- Gold ETFs bought 154kozs overnight.
