MACRO:

- The Dow Jones touched another record high overnight on the back of better than expected earnings.
- The Dow gained 60.81 points, the S&P500 lost 1.8 points, whilst the Nasdag eased 26.55 points.
- Financials were the best performers, up 0.62% whilst materials lagged, down 0.79%.
- European shares were mixed. The Euro STOXX fell 0.50%, the German Dax lost 0.40% whilst the UK FTSE was flat.
- The VIX gauge rose 1.46% to 10.44.
- US treasury yields were higher. The 2 year yield was 0.8 bps higher at 1.351% whilst the 10 year yield gained 1.4 bps to 2.294%.
- The dollar index was 0.41% lower to 92.873. The EUR traded up to 1.1846 whilst the USDJPY touched a low of 110.22.
- Oil prices were mixed. WTI was 0.5% higher at \$50.18 whilst Brent fell 0.4% to \$52.62.
- The CRB index rose 0.3% to 182.64.
- Base metals were higher, led by copper and zinc which were 0.8% higher.
- The July Chicago PMI was slightly better than expected at 58.9 vs 65.7 in June.
- European data confirmed an improvement in the labour market

PRECIOUS:

- Gold boosted by the soft greenback.
- Asia were on the offer yesterday, the SGE premium was the lowest it has been for a considerable period of time (\$5 over loco London).
- London were small buyers squeezing XAU back towards 1270.
- India has been trading in heavy discount putting topside pressure on the yellow metal.
- Silver traded buoyantly touching a high of 16.875 before easing into the close.



- PGM's traded firmly, with palladium nearing the psychological \$900 level.
- The Philadelphia gold and silver index lost 0.28%.
- Gold ETF's were flat with total holdings at 66.3 million ounces
